

RISE AND THRIVE

- Learning takes place during community service experiences
- Knowledge gained in these learnings can be applied to real life situations
- Emphasis on experiential learning, which is handson, achieved through internships
- Internship project can be proposed by the student or proposed by a partnering organization
- Internship can be local or India based
- India-based internships can be completed in any India location that is preferred by the volunteer's family







Internships

- Students 14+ years
- Applications open mid April for the year
- Through internships (local or India based) maximum of 3 per year of each
- Guidance and mentorship provided by college-aged student and one or more adult
- Opportunity to publish results of internship online or magazine/journal
- Reference letters
